Welcome to the Festival of Democracy, celebrating 75 years of Germany's constitution, the Basic Law! And that's not all – this year we are also celebrating 35 years since the fall of the Berlin Wall!

Today, we are united and connected throughout Germany by the rights and freedoms provided by the Basic Law. Many people nowadays envy us our democracy, our freedoms and our basic rights, which play a major role in our everyday lives – though we are not always aware of it.

Everyone is able to choose their vocation freely – Article 2, the right to free development of one's personality A woman can do anything a man can, and vice versa – Article 3. We can read, hear and see on a daily basis that freedom of the press and freedom of opinion are alive and well – Articles 5 and 11. These are just a few examples, that are joined by freedom of association, freedom of religion and the inviolability of the home.



Our Basic Law also provided a beacon to the many people who courageously demonstrated against the SED dictatorship. They wanted to live in a democracy. The Peaceful Revolution was a high point in the history of German freedom and democracy.

The Basic Law is a living piece of legislation which has been further developed in many key aspects by the German Bundestag, such as the sentence: "The state shall promote the actual implementation of equal rights for women and men and take steps to eliminate disadvantages that now exist."







#### **Security**

A set circular route leads through the Reichstag Building. There is no access from the Reichstag Building to the Paul Löbe Building.


We recommend starting your tour in the Paul Löbe Building and using the underground walkway to reach the Reichstag Building to take a look at the plenary chamber.




